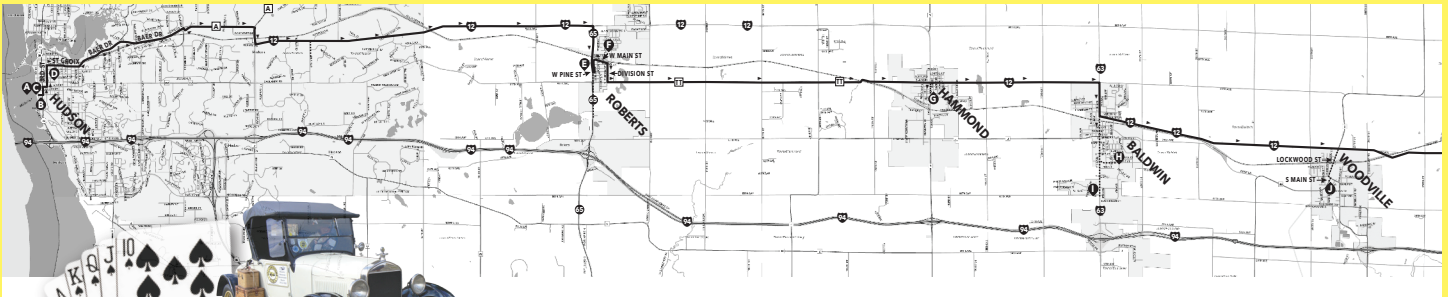

112 W Main Street, Roberts • Bring your stamped scorecard to receive your poker cards. \$100 prize for best hand and \$25 prize for worst hand.

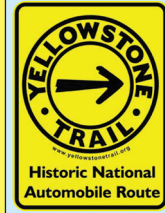
Score Cards are available at the Yellowstone Trail Info Booth and at the Poker Run Stops. See score card for rules, hours and locations.

Enjoy a **Sociability Drive** through St. Croix County on the historic Yellowstone Trail. While on the Trail you can play the Yellowstone Trail Poker Run. Score cards are available at the Poker Run Stops throughout the County.

The Yellowstone Trail starts at the Hudson Arch at 1st and Walnut Streets. Follow the Trail out of Hudson, past Dick's Bar on Walnut Street; north on 2nd Street; east on Vine Street and continue out of town on County Road UU. Turn north on County Road U, then east on Hwy 12.

Continue on Hwy 12 and follow the Trail east to Roberts; then south on Hwy 65. The roads have changed so for a modern road detour take County Road TT to Hammond. Continue east on Hwy 12, then south on Hwy 63 into Baldwin.

Travel to Woodville by retuning north on Hwy 63. Turn east onto Hwy 12 and continue to Lockwood Street/County Road D into Woodville.
