PLEASE NOTE:

The City of Hudson Public Transportation Program is a **door-to-door** shared-ride taxi service operating on a **demand-response** basis **within the city limits** of Hudson and in areas within Wisconsin within 5 miles of the city limits.

Please allow enough time

to arrive at your destination in case of unforeseen delays such as route deviations, bad weather, or peak service times.

The City of Hudson operates its Shared Ride Transit Program without regard to race, color, and national origin in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act. Reduced Fares

Riders aged 65 or older and those living with a disability qualify for a reduced rate of \$2.50 per ride during off-peak times, from 9:00 am to 4:30 pm, plus any surcharge for travel outside the City limits.
